FINANCE REPORT;

PRESIDENTS REPORT

Unfortunately due to the Covid pandemic and restrictions there has not been much activity at the Hall. We were unable to hold the AGM which was scheduled for March 2020 and we will aim to hold the next one on Monday 15th March 2021.

Leonie Neylon is wishing to step down from the Treasurer's position due to relocating. Asta Vickery will step into her role in the Interim until the AGM next year. Asta will arrange to meet with Leonie for handover. All positions will be open at the AGM. Michelle is wishing to stand down as the President after 4years in the role. We will advise the community at the Christmas Party that all positions need to be filled at the AGM in March 2021.

We were able to hold a Live broadcast of Derek's funeral at the Hall last month which was attended by 10 people. It was Derek's wishes for some of his Ashes to return to the Royal Oak and we aim to hold a special night to remember Derek. Date yet to be confirmed.
