

HUB DEVELOPMENT WORKS - GRAY STREET HAMILTON UPDATE

Businesses and residents are advised that a Works Within Road Reserves Permit has been approved for further works on the new entrance to the HUB Development in Gray Street Hamilton.

The works are being carried out by FOURSQ and include the removal of scaffolding, construction of a new entry to the mall, painting of the facade, new verandah and signage. Works are expected to take approximately six weeks to complete.

The footpath in front of the HUB will be closed for approximately three days from **Monday 13 to Wednesday 15 February 2017** while the scaffolding is removed. The pedestrian crossing will not be affected; however pedestrians will be diverted to the north side of Gray Street to ensure safety while the work is taking place.

There may be further intermittent closures of the footpath from time-to-time as necessary during the six week construction period. We understand that there may be some inconvenience caused during this period and appreciate the continued business and community understanding during this time.

HAMILTON-CHATSWORTH ROAD, BLACKWOOD-DUNKELD ROAD AND WOOLSTHORPE ROAD INTERSECTION (FIVE WAYS) BLACKSPOT UPGRADE, PENSHURST

As part of the Federal Government's Black Spot Program, Southern Grampians Shire Council will conduct road safety improvement works at the Hamilton-Chatsworth Road, Blackwood-Dunkeld Road and Woolsthorpe Road Intersection. The works include altering the existing Five Ways intersection north of Penshurst, to a staggered T intersection.

Works are scheduled to begin **20 February 2017 and are expected to be completed by late May 2017** (subject to weather conditions).

The total cost of this project is \$934,000 and is fully funded by the Federal Government.

Please note that appropriate traffic control measures will be in place for the duration of the works. Speed restrictions will be in place, parts of the road will be closed and lengthy delays may occur. Motorists are requested to be patient, to drive carefully at all times and to consider appropriate alternative routes for the duration of the works.
