



COLERAINE | PROPOSED DEVIATION AND SALE OF ROADS

Council proposes to deviate part of Cameron Street, Coleraine. Those parts of the road to be closed are as per the plan below and comprise both the government road and the freehold road vested in Council. The land onto which the road is to be deviated is shown as dotted in the image opposite.

If closed, Council proposes to sell the land from the discontinued sections of road by private treaty to the abutting property owners.

This proposal is made under sections 189, 206 and Schedule 10 Clause 2 of the Local Government Act 1989.

Any person wishing to make a submission on the proposal must do so in writing by **Friday 8 September 2017**. Submissions should be addressed to:

A person making a submission is entitled to request in the submission that they wish to appear in person, or to be represented by a person specified in the submission, at a meeting to be heard in support of that submission.

Any person requesting to appear in person or to be represented by a person specified in his or her submission will be notified of the day, time and place of the meeting of Council (or a Committee of Council) determined by the Council to hear submissions. All submissions will be considered in accordance with section 223 of the Act.

Submitters should note that Council is required to make available for public inspection submissions received in accordance with section 223 for a period of 12 months.

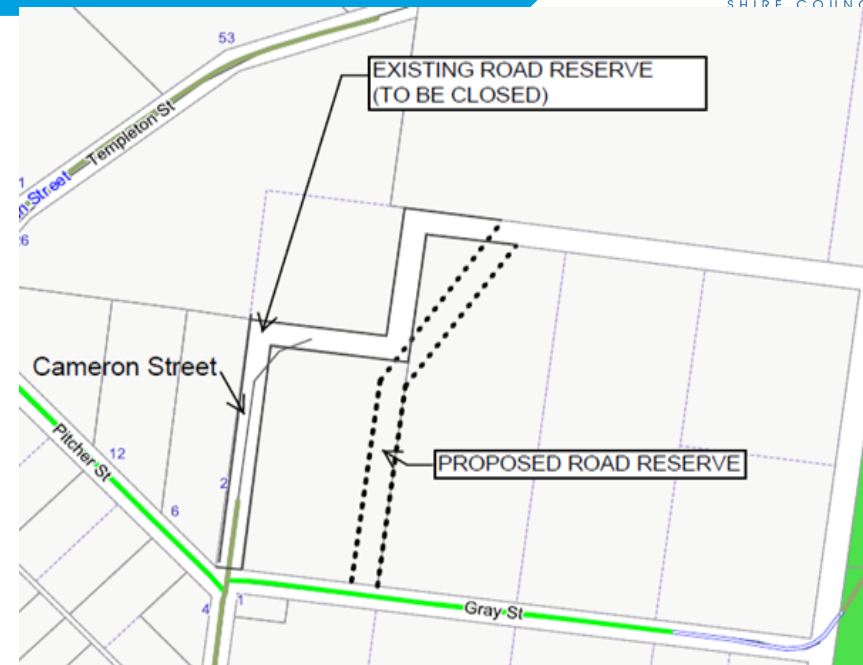
Following consideration of submissions Council may decide to deviate the roads, parts of the road, or not to deviate the road.
