

PARTIAL CLOSURE OF TYERS STREET FOR MODIFICATION OF RAISED PEDESTRAIN CROSSINGS

As part of Council's Capital Works Program 2018/19, the existing pedestrian crossing on Tyers Street are to be altered to flatten the existing ramps at both sides. The construction work will commence on **Monday, 14 January 2019 at Tyers Street**. It is anticipated the works will be completed within five days, weather permitting.

During works, the road will be confined to a single lane and traffic control will be in place. Delays are expected during construction and the council suggests motorists and pedestrians to avoid the areas if possible. The proposed modifications to the existing crossing will improve pedestrian safety at this high traffic location.
