PROPOSED LEASE | DUNDAS QUARRY SITE

Southern Grampians Shire Council (Council) gives notice under section 190 of the Local Government Act 1989 (Act) of its intention to enter into a new lease agreement with Boral Resources (Vic) Pty Ltd for the Dundas Quarry site, Mt Napier Access Road. The original term of the lease is for five (5) years with three (3) by five (5) year options to extend. The site of the quarry is shown in the below diagram.

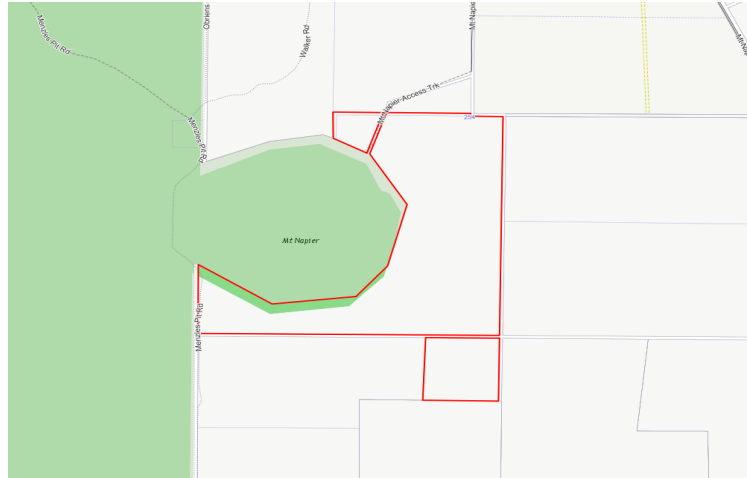

Any person requesting in person or to be represented by a person specified in his or her submission will be notified of the day, time and place of the meeting of Council (or a Committee of Council) determined by the Council to hear submissions.

All submissions will be considered in accordance with section 223 of the Act. Submitters should note that Council is required to make available for public inspection submissions received in accordance with section 223 for a period of 12 months.
