

HAMILTON-CHATSWORTH ROAD, BLACKWOOD-DUNKELD ROAD AND WOOLSTHORPE ROAD INTERSECTION (FIVE WAYS) BLACKSPOT UPGRADE, PENSHURST

As part of the Federal Government's Black Spot Program, Southern Grampians Shire Council will conduct road safety improvement works at the Hamilton-Chatsworth Road, Blackwood-Dunkeld Road and Woolsthorpe Road Intersection. The works include altering the existing Five Ways intersection north of Peshurst, to a staggered T intersection.

Works are scheduled to begin **20 February 2017 and are expected to be completed by late May 2017** (subject to weather conditions).

The total cost of this project is \$934,000 and is fully funded by the Federal Government.

Please note that appropriate traffic control measures will be in place for the duration of the works. Speed restrictions will be in place, parts of the road will be closed and lengthy delays may occur. Motorists are requested to be patient, to drive carefully at all times and to consider appropriate alternative routes for the duration of the works.
