

COLERAINE FLOOD INVESTIGATION COMMUNITY INFORMATION SESSION

Southern Grampians Shire, Venant Solutions, Utilis and the Glenelg Hopkins CMA, invite members of the Coleraine community to the third community session for this important project.

This project has been funded by the Victorian State Government and is delivering a suite of information vital to understanding how flood risk at Coleraine can be managed.

This session will provide the opportunity to:

- Get an update on overall project progress
- Hear about recommendations for improved management of flood risk via amendment of the Southern Grampians Shire planning scheme; and
- the outcomes of the flood mitigation feasibility assessment, which has examined options identified and prioritised at the second community session (held last December).

The session will conclude with an outline of the topics to be covered in the fourth and final community session, which will mark completion of the project.

The meeting will be held at the **Karingal Senior Citizens Rooms**, Henty Street Coleraine, commencing at **7pm on Thursday 13 September**.
