Nominations are invited in the categories of Citizen of the Year, Young Citizen of the Year, and Community Event of the Year. Nominations are also sought for the Shire's Community Recognition Awards, which seek to acknowledge outstanding contributions to the community by an individual.

To be eligible for the Citizen of the Year Award, nominated persons must be 25 years or older on 26 January 2018 whilst nominees for the Young Citizen of the Year Award must be under 25 years of age on 26 January 2018. Age restrictions do not apply to the Community Event of the Year or Council's own Community Recognition Awards.
