

SHEEPVENTION | TEMPORARY ROAD/STREET CLOSURES

Council wishes to advise that the following streets will be **temporarily closed** for the occasion of Hamilton Sheepvention between the hours of **6.00am - 6.00pm Monday 6 August** and **Tuesday 7 August** at the following:

- **Shakespeare Street** from King Street to Dickens Street. Reopens **4.00pm Tuesday 7 August**
- **Milton Street** between Market Place and Brown Street
- **College Street** from Horner Street. Restricted to property owners only. Will be reopened to traffic from **12 noon Tuesday 7 August**
- **Horner Street** no parking on both sides of road from Shakespeare Street to past main Showgrounds entrance gates. This will be a designated set down area and disabled parking area (in addition to parking provided at HILAC)

It should be noted that **Shakespeare Street** (between Dickens and HILAC) will also be closed on **Sunday 5 August from 12 noon to 6.00pm**.
