

SHEEPVENTION | TEMPORARY ROAD/STREET CLOSURES

Council wishes to advise that the following streets will be **temporarily closed** for the occasion of Hamilton Sheepvention between the hours of **6.00am - 6.00pm Monday 7 August** and **Tuesday 8 August** at the following locations:

- **Shakespeare Street** (the parking area beside the Showgrounds from Sheep Pavilion to Lions Club Pavilion)
- **Shakespeare Street** (between King and Dickens Streets) from 12 noon - 6.00pm Sunday 6 August and reopen from 4.00pm Tuesday 8 August
- **Milton Street** (between Shakespeare Street and Market Place)
- **College Street** (the part that is a No Through Road from Horner Street) to be restricted to property owners only until 12 noon Tuesday 8 August

Additional/amended closure times apply to the following street:

- **Horner Street** (easterly traffic only, between Shakespeare and Victoria Streets) until 12 noon Tuesday 8 August; and then between Shakespeare Street and College Street until 6.00pm Tuesday 8 August

One way Traffic in the following streets during **6.00am - 6.00pm Monday 7 August** and **Tuesday 8 August**:

- Clifford Street
- College Street - between Horner and Macpherson Streets
- Coulter Avenue
- Elmore Street
- Leopold Avenue
- McDonald Avenue
- Wells Street
- Wright Street

No Standing areas will be implemented in the following streets:

- William Court (east side)
- Wright Street (inside of bend)
- Elmore Street (inside of bend)
- McDonald Avenue (inside of bend)
- Shakespeare/King Streets intersection
- Victoria/King Streets intersection
- Horner Street (between Shakespeare Street and ten metres east of Main Showgrounds Gate except bus/car drop-off area and limited disabled parking)

Access to and from adjacent properties are to remain unrestricted during these periods.

HILAC users during this period can **access HILAC from King Street**.

SHEEPVENTION | HAMILTON TOWN BUS SERVICE

Council wishes to advise that the Hamilton Town Bus Service Stop **Route 02 NORTH RUN** will be diverted in both directions due to Sheepvention, effective **6.00am - 6.00pm Monday 7 and Tuesday 8 August**.

It will divert from Shakespeare Street into Dickens Street, Stephens Street, Stewart Street, Mount Baimbridge Road into King Street.
