LOUTH SWAMP BRIDGE - TEMPORARY ROAD/STREET CLOSURE

Council wishes to advise of the temporary road closure between Blohms Road and Louth Swamp Road for the Louth Swamp Bridge replacement works and road reinstatement.

Stage 1 work commences **Monday 16 December 2019**, with anticipated stage 1 completion date **Sunday 5 January 2020**. The road will be partially closed with a traffic management plan in affect for the duration of construction.

Stage 2 works will commence **Monday 6 January 2020**. The road will be completely closed to traffic until approximately **28 February 2020**. A detour will be in place. Council thanks the community for their patience and cooperation while we complete these important works.

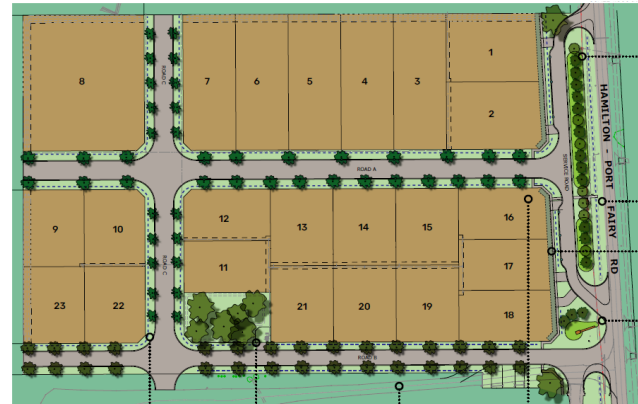
SALE OF LAND - HAMILTON INDUSTRIAL ESTATE, PORT FAIRY ROAD, HAMILTON

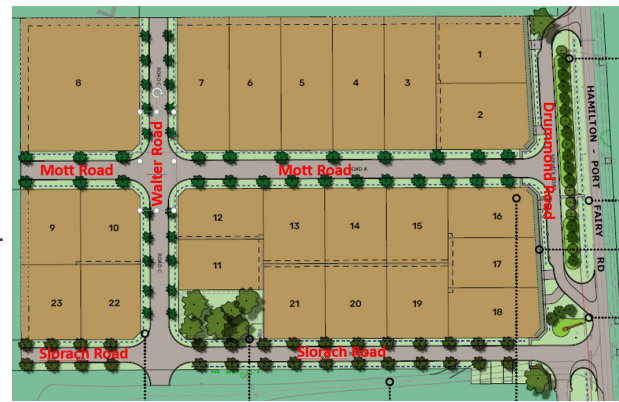
PROPOSED ROAD NAMES - HAMILTON INDUSTRIAL ESTATE, PORT FAIRY ROAD, HAMILTON
