

## ROAD CLOSURES FOR CULVERT REPLACEMENT WORKS - EAST WEST ROAD

Council will carry out major culvert replacement works at three sites on East West Road starting **Tuesday 4 February 2020**. Two culverts between Hamilton-Natimuk Road and Cavendish-Glendenning Road will be replaced first with the third culvert between Cavendish-Glendenning Road and Montana Road following after completion of the first two.

It is anticipated that the majority of these works will be completed by **Friday 21 February 2020**, subject to weather conditions.

Road closures will be in place while culvert replacement works are completed. Each site is expected to be closed for up to five days. Once culvert replacement works at each site are completed the affected section of road will be re-opened. Please avoid the area if possible.
