DUNKELD ARBORETUM DAM WALL RESTORATION WORKS

Council would like to advise residents in Dunkeld that works have commenced on the reinstatement of the Dunkeld Arboretum Dam Wall that was damaged in the 2016 floods.

The project is being delivered in partnership with the Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning through National Disaster Relief Funding arrangements.

Major construction works include de-watering of the dam, construction of a new spillway, re-strengthening of the upstream embankment, removal of trees along the upstream embankment, removal of the existing jetty and relocation of the existing pump infrastructure.

The project is due to be completed by the end of April 2020, subject to weather conditions.
