CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) RESPONSE: UPDATE ON COUNCIL OPERATIONS

Council services and facilities are now open in line with the recent State Government restrictions as announced on Tuesday 27 July 2021.

This includes Customer Service Centres at Brown Street and Market Place, Visitor Information Centres, Transfer Stations across the Shire, HRLX, Family Day Care and Occasional Care, Maternal Health and Home Community Care Services.

The below services are now open, but are subject to the following restrictions:

- **Hamilton Library** - Subject to density quotient of 1 per 4 sqm. Limited to 100 patrons. Children's programs remain on hold until further notice. Mobile library service resumes.
- **Hamilton Cinema** - Limited to 35 patrons. Bookings are essential.
- **HILAC** – Subject to density quotient of 1 per 4 sqm. No 24/7 gym. Maximum group limited to 10.
- **Caravan Parks** (Peshurst and Coleraine) - Open. Bookings permitted for single households.

The Hamilton Performing Arts Centre remains closed but will reopen in the near future.
