## TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - MURROA BUCKLEY SWAMP ROAD

Council wishes to advise the Murroa Buckley Swamp Road will be temporarily closed from **1 July 2020** for the purpose of road works, including gravel resheeting.

The road will be closed from Hamilton Port Fairy Road through to Mt Napier Road until **7 August 2020**. Road closure signs will be in place and emergency vehicles will have access to the entire length of road and properties during this time. Access to the Mt Napier State Park will be available via Murroa Lane and Coles Track.
