The Southern Grampians Shire Council are developing a Masterplan for our Volcanic Assets and Landscapes and invite residents to have their say at a community drop in session or via the online survey for the development of the Greater Hamilton Regional Volcanic Trail.

The volcanic sites within the Southern Grampians Shire have remained relatively undeveloped and largely overlooked as a tourist destination. The development of the Volcanic Trail presents an opportunity to not only develop the visitor economy of the Shire, but to preserve and protect these important sites for future generations.

As valued community assets, the Southern Grampians Shire Council recognises there is significant interest from stakeholders in any proposal to change or install new infrastructure at many of these sites. It is essential community members have their say in the master plan process.
