## CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) RESPONSE: UPDATE ON COUNCIL OPERATIONS

Due to the recent restrictions announced by the State Government on Thursday 5 August 2021, a number of Southern Grampians Shire Council services and facilities will be closed for face-to-face transactions until further notice.

This includes Customer Service Centres at Brown Street and Market Place, Visitor Information Centres in Hamilton and Dunkeld, HILAC, Greater Hamilton Library, Hamilton Gallery and Hamilton Performing Arts Centre. Kerbside waste and recycling services will continue to operate as normal and Transfer Stations will remain open with eftpos only.
