

BLUE GREEN ALGAE ALERT FOR LAKE HAMILTON LIFTED

Southern Grampians Shire Council is pleased to advise that the alert on Blue Green Algae at Lake Hamilton has now been lifted.

Compliant laboratory reports have returned satisfactory blue green algae cell count results and Lake Hamilton can now be used for recreation activities.

In the interests of public safety and in accordance with the Lake Hamilton Management Plan, Council's Environmental Health Department will continue to monitor the lake's water quality closely.

Signage warning of health risks will be removed from the lake foreshore over the coming week.
