

Temporary Detour - COX STREET

Cox Street Hamilton will be closed to Heavy Vehicles throughout the construction of the Cox Street Redevelopment - a temporary detour will be in place.

The \$4 million Cox Street Redevelopment is expected to commence in January 2022. This project will activate prime retail frontage, address access and safety issues and improve community amenity at this major entrance into Hamilton.

During construction, Cox Street will be reduced to one lane only. As a result, Council will temporarily detour heavy vehicles from Cox Street for the duration of the works. This will ensure safety for those working on the project, pedestrians and motorists.

The temporary detour route requires heavy vehicles to follow Coleraine Road, Mount Baimbridge Road, Portland Road, South Boundary Road, Mt Napier Road, Petschels Lane, Hamilton Highway and Ballarat Road.

This route was selected as it is an approved route for heavy vehicles and affects the least number of households of all options considered.

Council thanks the community for their cooperation and patience while we complete this important project.
