All the buildings and structures being: homestead, laundry, cool house, carpenter's shop, men's hut, bluestone hitching wall, brick stables, elevated barn, woolshed, bluestone and weatherboard cottage, and concrete block silo; all the unmade roads as follows: main driveway and turning circle at back of the house; the trees as follows: 'Michaelangelo' pine tree, 'Cowthorp' oak and 'Palestine' oak in front garden, the avenues of eight 'coronation tree' oaks, the five elms in a quadrant at rear of house; the landscape features as follows:
